Somewhere safe and affordable to live is important to everyone.

Any one of us can find ourselves homeless for lots of reasons: a relationship breakdown, financial problems or getting a notice to vacate.

This Tasmanian Homelessness Charter:

- tells you what rights you have
- says what you can expect when you ask for help.

It is important because if you are, or might become homeless, you can feel vulnerable and this is when your rights matter most.

The Charter is a statement of core values and is subject to the reasonable limits of the law of Tasmania.
