Shelter accommodation

Shelters provide safe and affordable crisis accommodation for people who don't have a safe place to sleep.

How can I get to a shelter?

Shelters are available to people facing homeless, including people living in an unsafe situation. Getting a place at a shelter is prioritised based on each person's needs and the needs of any accompanying children. Shelters also consider:

- safety concerns (for you, other residents and staff)
- your health and mobility needs
- your ability to live in a communal environment.

To access a shelter, you can contact them directly or call Housing Connect on 1800 800 588. If a shelter is unable to provide you a place, they will refer you to Housing Connect for support and assistance.

What does it cost?

Shelter accommodation is affordable with rent set at 25 per cent of your income, plus any Commonwealth Rent Assistance you may be eligible for.

Shelters may ask for a bond of up to two weeks' rent. If you can't pay the bond upfront, you can discuss payment plans with your shelter worker.

What can I expect at a shelter?

You can expect to be supported in a safe and respectful environment.

Shelters provide on-site support 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

They will help you identify and work towards your housing and other goals for life.

All residents are required to treat staff and their other residents with care and respect.

What shelters can help me?

Homes Tasmania funds shelters across the state that provide crisis accommodation and support for people.
